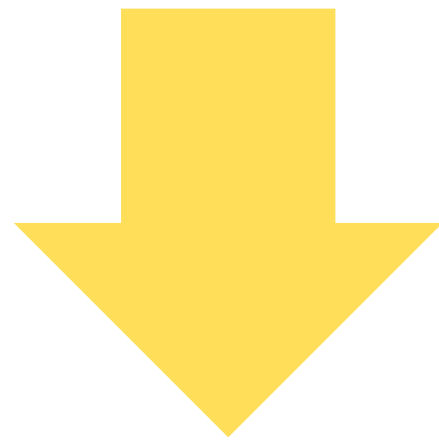

HOW DO I BUILD IN CULTURE?

Problema: Abuela Carmen has misplaced the figurines that get baked into the Roscón de Navidad. The holidays won't be the same without this important tradition! Can you find the figurines before it's too late and the holidays are ruined?

Objetivo: Your group is solving a puzzle. The correct answers to the question clues will give you a "secret code" to unlock a series of digital locks. Each lock that you open will give you access to the next clue. Solve all the clues and unlock all the locks to find Abuela's figurines!

Premio: The groups who locate the misplaced figurines will get a good grade and a sweet treat, and will forever be in Abuela's good graces!
