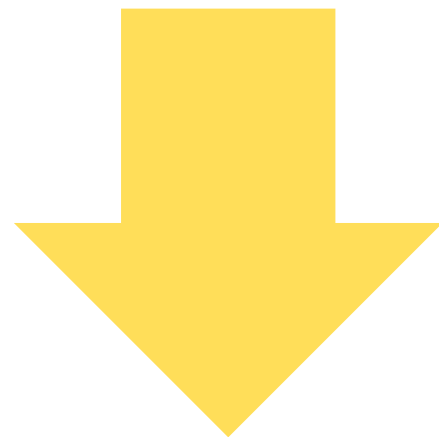

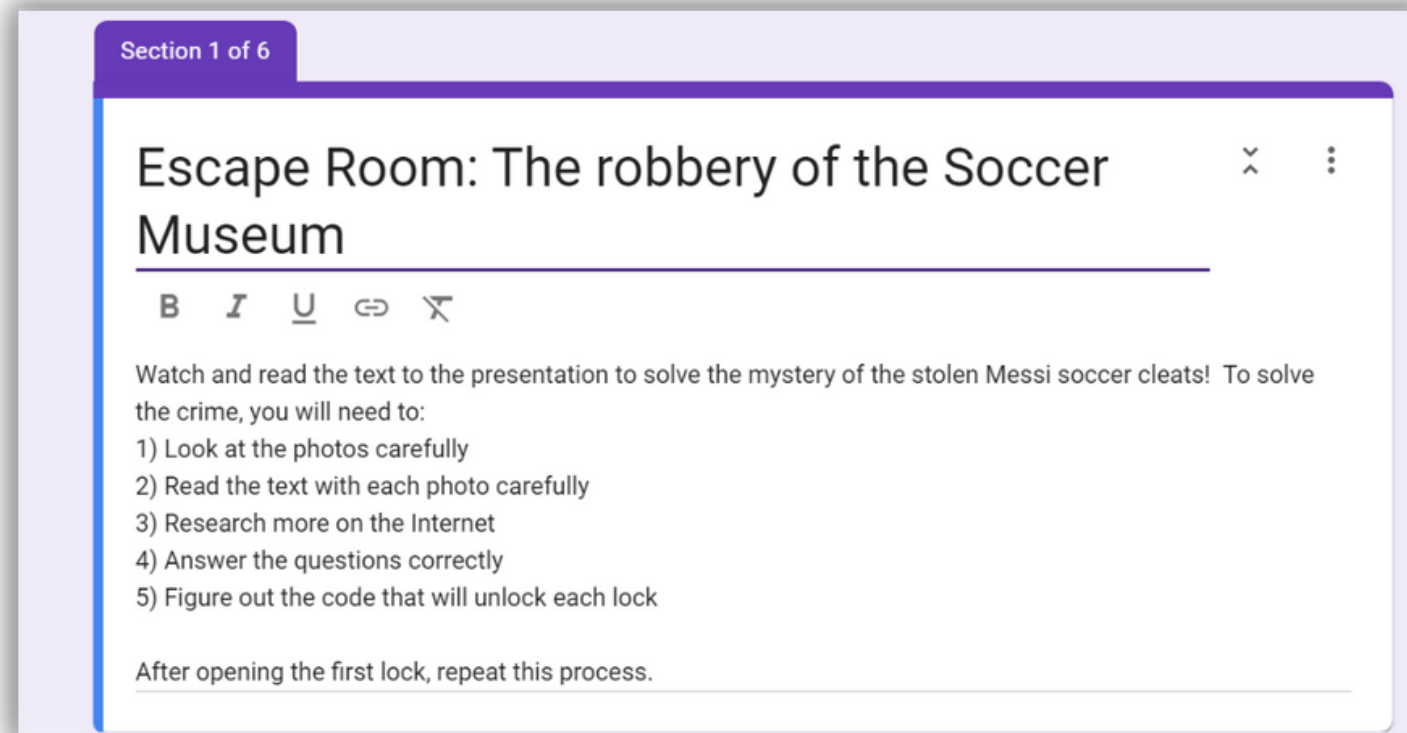
HOW DO I BUILD IN CULTURE?

Instructions

1. For each digital lock, you will need to look at the photos and read the speaker notes in google slides. Stay OUT of present mode.
2. The last slide will have a link to the questions.
3. Answer the questions by looking at the pictures, reading the information in the speaker notes or by using the Internet.
4. Something in the questions will lead you to the right code to open the lock! You will need to think “outside” the box! Type your answer into the google form. If you’re right, the next set of clues will appear. If you’re wrong, it will ask you to try again.
5. Your time limit is the class period. You may ask for help, but you receive a deduction in points. The winning team will bring me back the missing objects first!

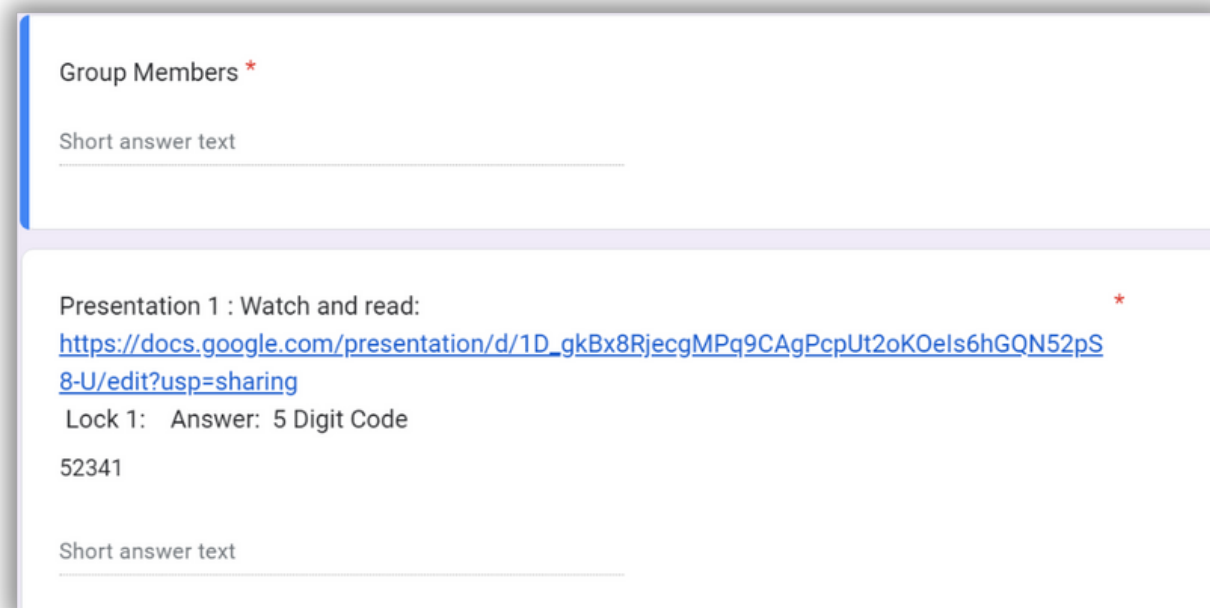
This escape room is all digital- so you post and go!



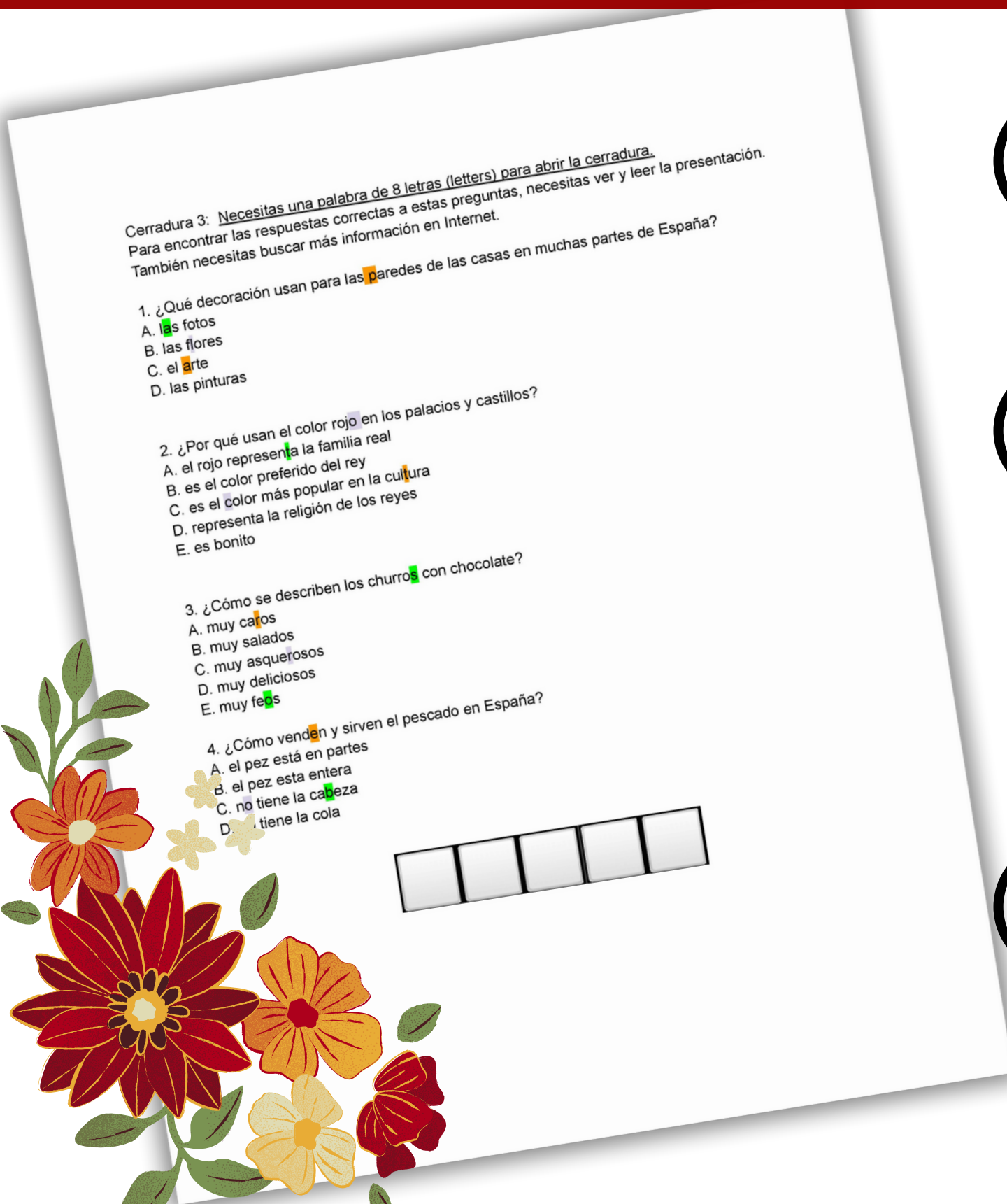
Set the scene by reviewing the first few slides together; Leo Messi's cleats and jersey have been stolen!



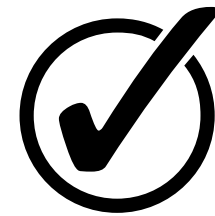
Now students must view the Google Slides presentation and read the captions to answer the accompanying questions.

Using the provided Google Form, students type in their code. If they're right, the next slide show & questions pops up!

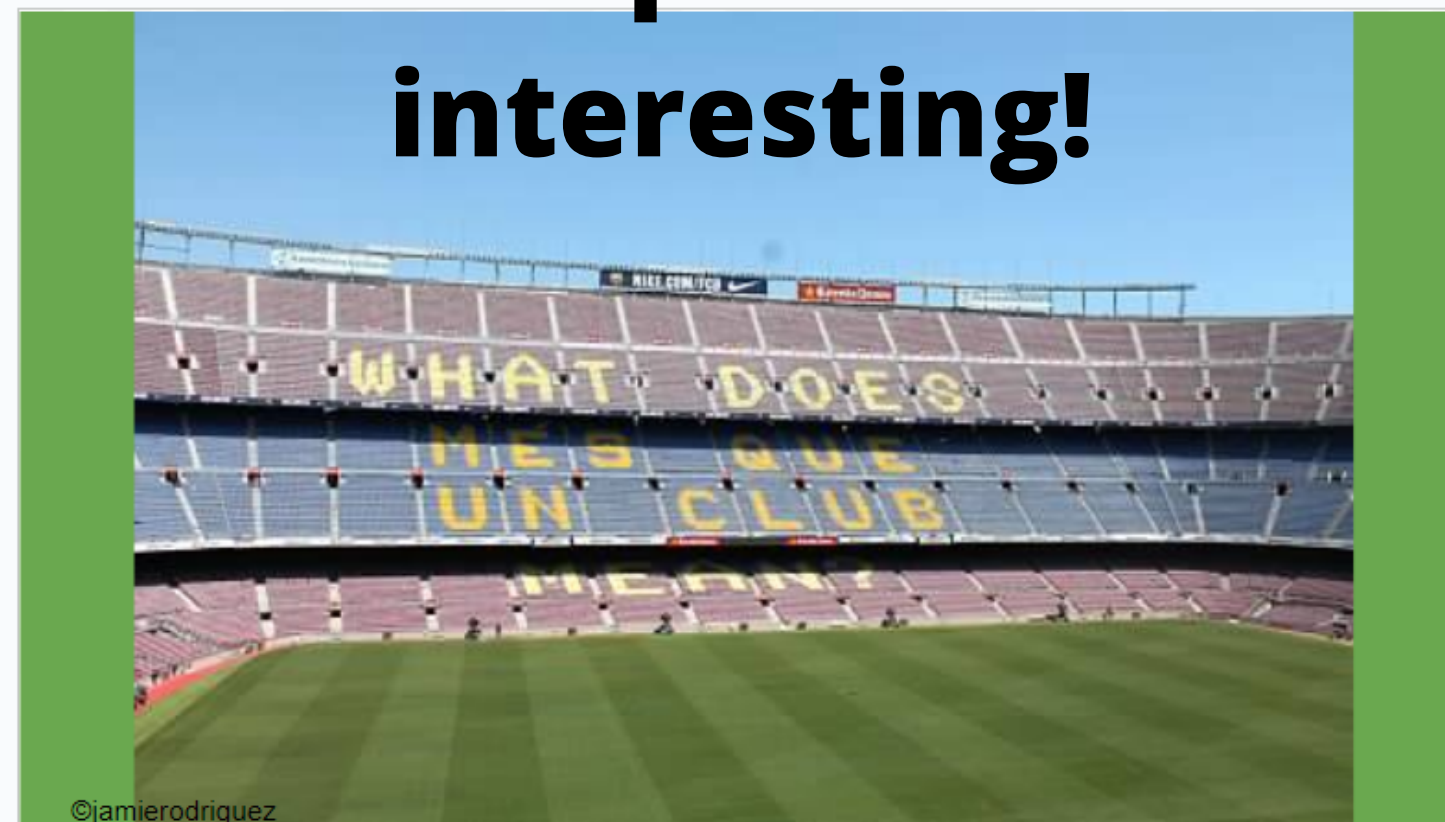


But it's not always straight forward! Sometimes students will need to figure out a riddle to get the code!
